VARADERO, Cuba, Sep 30 (acn) The Varadero Golf Club will host from next Tuesday the 8th edition of the Cuba Golf Grand Tournament, which will be attended this time by Greg Norman, famous former professional athlete, ranked number one for 331 consecutive weeks.

According to a press note released by the organizing committee of the international contest, Norman will be in charge of the opening remarks and he will also offer photography and filming sessions along with special guests, players and public.

Greg Norman, Australian known as "The Great White Shark" won 91 tournaments during his fruitful career, and was inducted to the Hall of Fame of this sport in 2001, same year in which he finished his career as golfer.

Palmares S.A, responsible for golf competitions in Cuba, together with traditional sponsors of the championship and collaborators, will make of this tournament a successful event, says the note. Previous editions of the event have been attended by players from more than a dozen countries and internationally renowned golfers invited as guests like South African Ernie Els, Spanish Alvaro Quiros and British Tony Jacklin.

The development of golf and real estate agencies associated with this sport is included in the strategy of the Ministry of Tourism to boost this sector which already exceeds the figure of three million annual visitors to Cuba.
